

MANDELA DAY 2022 HILLBROW CLEAN UP, COVID – 19 CONSENT INDEMNITY & UNDERTAKING FORM

The Mandela Day 2022 Hillbrow Clean-up is a voluntary event where participants follow the Adopt a Street Volunteers Network which is a voluntary association of registered participants run by an Adopt a Street Volunteers Network management team operated on a per street basis. Volunteers participate at every Adopt a Street clean-up event at their own risk and without express permission from the Board of Directors of Clean City South Africa.

The Mandela Day 2022 Hillbrow Clean-up adheres to all Covid-19 protocols in line with the National Health Act 61 of 2003 and its Regulations.

Participation in a clean-up operation takes some physical effort. Therefore, if you have any medical conditions, it is advisable that you consult your GP before performing the activity. You must accept that the Participating Organisation and its participants do so entirely at your own risk and take responsibility to ensure that participants are healthy and fit to participate in the clean-up event.

All children under the age of 11 years old should always be accompanied by their parents or guardians throughout the clean-up operation.

The Clean City SA management team do not accept responsibility for injury, loss and/or damage sustained by a participant during the clean-up event.

As an Organisation, we understand and declare that:

- The COVID-19 virus has a long incubation period during which carriers of the virus may not show symptoms and still be highly contagious.
- Due to the characteristics of the virus, and the characteristics of touch rugby activities, I have an elevated risk of contracting the virus simply by being at the event.
- High risk people include persons over the age of 60, persons who have pre-existing medical conditions such as: asthma, chronic lung conditions, hypertension, autoimmune disease, organ transplants, cancer, immunocompromised, obesity (BMI over 40) and liver or kidney disease conditions. We confirm that our participants do not fall into any of these high-risk categories.
- We are aware of the risks involved with the spread of COVID-19 and the risks it may hold to our participants health and the health of others we come in contact with.
- We accept all of the above risks and conditions and indemnify and hold Clean City SA, Sportsman Events PTY Ltd, the City of Johannesburg, all sponsors and local councils, including and not limited to all staff as well as the designated compliance officers harmless, against any loss, cost, claim or liability arising as a result of a failure by the to comply with the conditions herein.
- To the best of my knowledge, our participants are free from the COVID-19 virus,
- Our participants have not had any symptoms of COVID-19 in the 14 days immediately before the start of this event and we will adhere to this condition throughout the duration of this event:
Cough, Sore throat, Shortness of breath, Fever (body temperature of 37.5 degrees or more), Loss of smell, Loss of taste, Diarrhoea, Nausea & vomiting, Chills, Body pains and Headaches
- Our participants have not been in contact with a COVID-19 confirmed or suspected case in the 14 days immediately before the start of this event, and we will adhere to this condition throughout the duration of this event.

We undertake that we will abide by all the regulations and rules for participation in this event as laid out in the Terms & Conditions of Entry and Covid-19 Safety Protocols, a copy of which we have received and read. Furthermore, I have read and understood the terms of this consent, indemnity and undertaking as and confirm we will comply therewith in full.
